

## DC Packing List (May 30-June 4, 2017)

**Remember the school dress code MUST be followed!!!!!!!!!!!!**

### Items to have on the bus

- Pillow
- Small blanket (it can get cool on the bus at night)
- Snacks (no sunflower seeds)
- Soda/Water (in a plastic bottle with a replaceable top)
- Sunglasses
- Camera
- Cell Phone (limited or no charging will be available until we reach the hotel)
- Clothes to change into for sleeping
- New clothes for Wednesday (shirt, pants/shorts & undergarments)
- Sweatshirt or jacket
- Toothpaste/toothbrush
- Hair brush
- Contact supplies
- Deodorant
- Skin care items to wash up in the morning and at night
- Things to do on bus – ipod/mp3(with earbuds/head phones), DS, books, magazines, etc
- **I-Pads/Tablets can be brought at your own risk**
- **Movies (G, PG, PG-13) to be watched on the bus (subject to teacher approval)**
- **NO computers or portable DVD players, medication OR hats**

- Comfortable tennis shoes (already broken in) (*You can wear flip flops on the bus and in the hotel, but must wear tennis shoes for our days of walking in DC*)
- Pajamas
- Undergarments
- Shampoo/Soap
- Make-up
- Sunscreen
- Chargers for your electronics
- Plastic bag for dirty clothes
- **NO HATS**
- **ALL MEDICATIONS MUST BE TURNED INTO THE MAIN OFFICE NO LATER THAN TUESDAY, MAY 23 (A GREEN MEDICAL FORM MUST ACCOMPANY EVERY MEDICATION- PRESCRIPTIONS MUST BE SIGNED BY A DOCTOR, OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATION SIGNED BY PARENT)**
